Using Picture Books in the Classroom

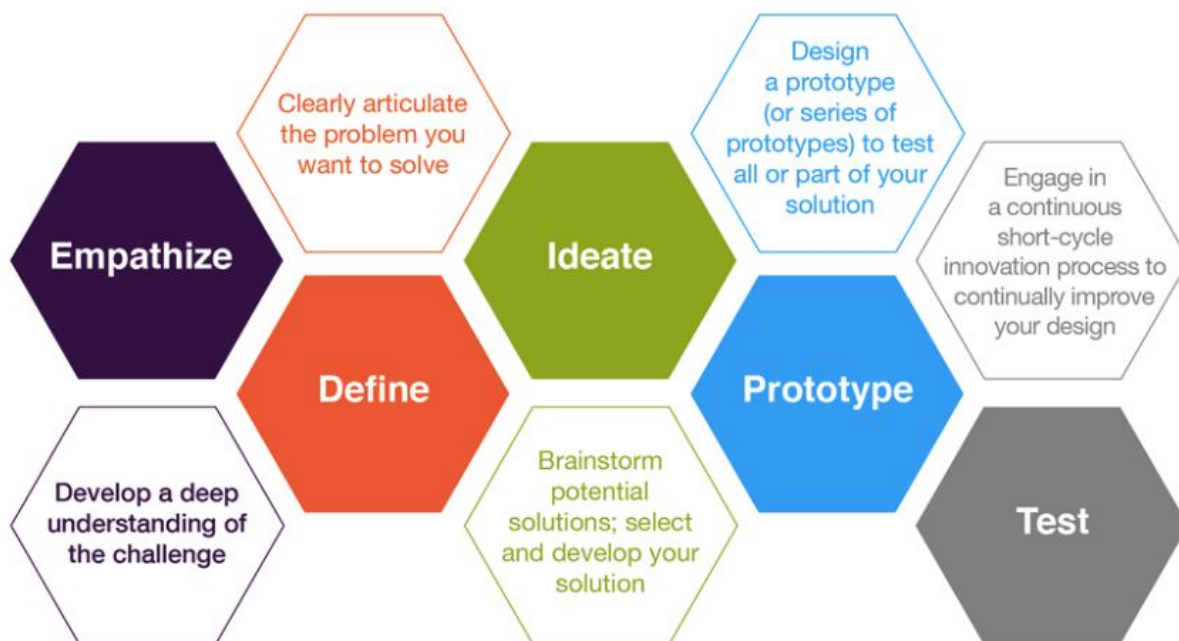
A read aloud can be a powerful entry point into classroom dialogue and discussion. As a literacy strategy, listening to a book being read well is probably one of the most valuable and pleasurable experiences beginning readers and writers can have.



Read a picture book aloud with participants seated in a semicircle initially, ensuring that all can see the images clearly. Visual literacy – decoding images – is as important as decoding text.
